The dance floor was packed through the night as the Chris Michaels Band kept us hopping. Our bellies were stuffed thanks to Frank Russo's and his exceptional staff.

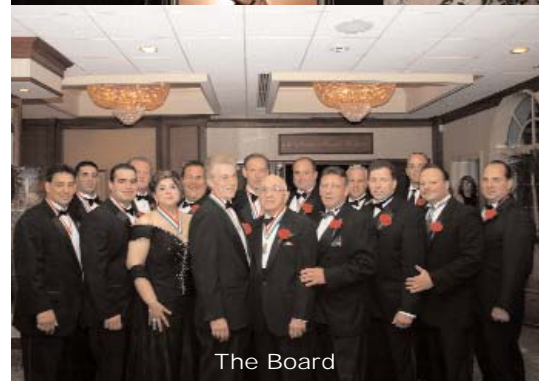

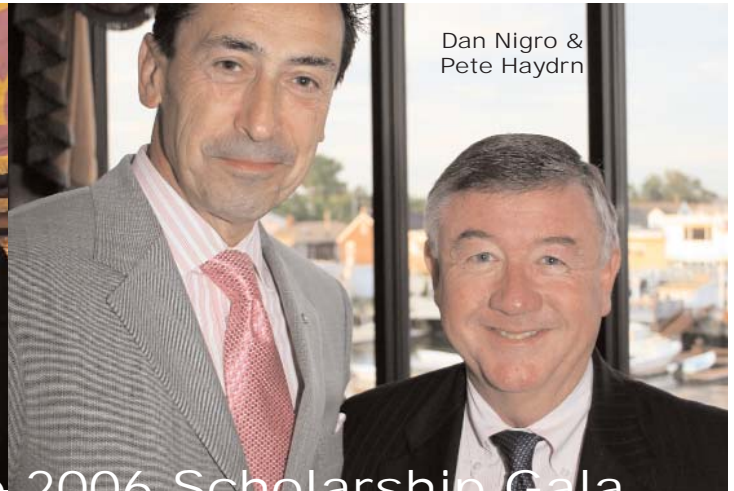
GET OUT AND VOTE!

In April 2006, for the first time since becoming a Republic in 1946, Italy allowed its 3.5 million citizens living abroad to vote in a national election by absentee ballots. Of the 3.5 million Italian citizens living abroad who were eligible to vote, 1.1 million actually did. North America's estimated 200,000 votes elected one Senator and two Deputies. In all 12 Deputies and 6 Senators will represent Italian expatriates. The main political issues for Expatriates, was improving RAI satellite TV reception, extending hours of local consulates and improving their performance, preserving Italian language and culture.

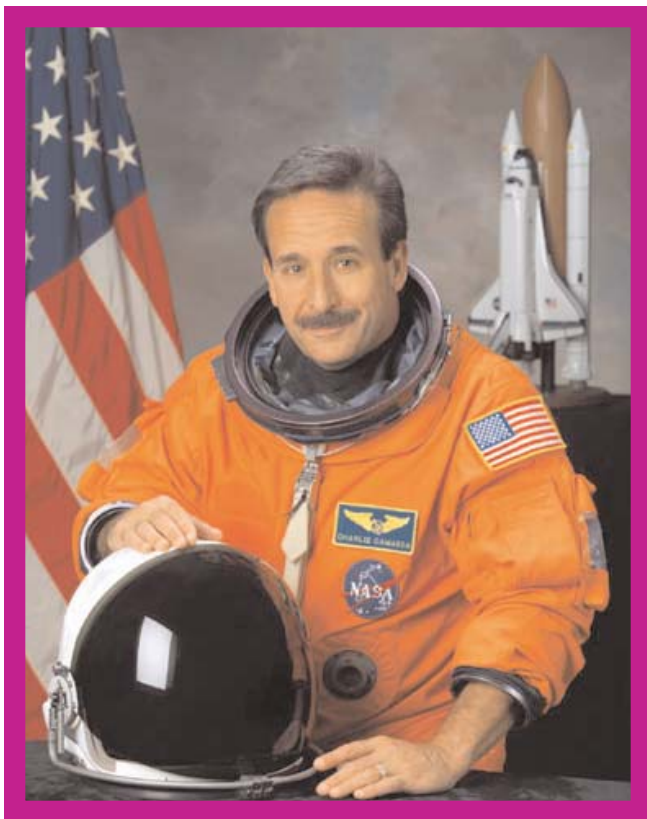
